 Voters may also submit a request for an absentee ballot by email or fax if it contains an original signature. Original such requests must also be mailed to the Auditor with a postmark date no later than the pre-registration deadline for the election for which the ballot was reguested (October 24th, 2022 for the General Election).

· All requests must include the voter's name, birthdate, residence address, mailing address if different, name or date of election, along with the following new required information: Iowa Driver's License number or Nonoperator Iowa ID number, or if you do not have an Iowa ID then you must use the IVoter issued PIN number. Please call the Auditor's Office at 319-267-2670 for help in finding your Voter PIN number if you do not have or cannot find your Iowa ID.
