CITY OF CLARKSVILLE CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING February 5, 2018

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session February 5, 2018, in the Temporary Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Val Swinton in the chair and Council Members Roger Doty, Todd Fails, Jeff Kolb, Diane Renning, and Kenny Smith present.

Motion Renning, Smith, to approve and adopt the items contained in the Consent Agenda: Motion to approve minutes (January 2, 2018, January 15, 2018, and January 22, 2018).

RCV – Ayes: Doty, Fails, Kolb, Renning and Smith. Nays: None. MC.

Mike Miner, Executive Director for the Butler County Conservation Board, discussed the bike trail repair project. Lowering the trail between approximately 1.5 feet to 2 feet lower for about 350 feet is the most that can be done while still fitting into the FEMA scope of repair. The total cost of the project is \$218,000.00. FEMA will pay 75%, the State pays 10%, and Butler County Conservation pays the remaining 15%. Trail modeling was completed as proposed and showed a slight decrease in water elevation north of the lowered trail section during extreme flooding events (such as 2008 and 2016). Trees must be removed by March 20, 2018. Work cannot take place between the end of March 2018 through November 2018 due to the area having endangered long-eared bats.
