With no public access to the courthouse due to COVID-19, this meeting was held telephonically with the public able to participate. This complies with Iowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or impractical."

Meeting called to order at 9 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with members Greg Barnett and Rusty Eddy present. Also present were Auditor Lizbeth Williams, First Deputy Auditor Mary Brouwer, Engineer John Riherd, County Attorney Greg Lievens, Sheriff Jason Johnson, Director of Public Health Jennifer Becker, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter, Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze, Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, Assessor Michele Shultz, Network Administrator Sara Trepp, Recorder Janice Jacobs, John Lühring and Clay Hoppenworth, Parkersburg, Iowa, Leslie Groen, Allison, Iowa, John Zimmerman, Greene, Iowa and Bethany Carson, Mid-America Publishing.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Time and place for a public hearing on a Construction Permit Application by Kpoppens 290<sup>th</sup> Finisher Farm for a new swine facility. Owner Kyle Poppens. Location of proposed facility is in the SE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 5 Tier 90N Range 16W of Albion Township. Present were Auditor Lizbeth Williams, First Deputy Auditor Mary Brouwer, Engineer John Riherd, County Attorney Greg Lievens, Sheriff Jason Johnson, Director of Public Health Jennifer Becker, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter, Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze, Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, Assessor Michele Shultz, Network Administrator Sara Trepp, Recorder Janice Jacobs, John Lühring and Clay Hoppenworth, Parkersburg, Iowa, Leslie Groen, Allison, Iowa, John Zimmerman, Greene, Iowa and Bethany Carson, Mid-America Publishing. Auditor Williams reported no written or oral comments were received. Clay Hoppenworth, Parkersburg, Iowa asked what the Master Matrix score of the facility was. Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze responded that a Matrix is not triggered unless the site is over 1,000 animal units, reporting that this facility will have 980 animal units. He warned of another site that will be built within two miles of the Parkersburg golf course that he is concerned with and thought all residents of Parkersburg should be, too. Specialist Kroeze reported that the new confinement, Sinclair Finisher Farm is under 1,000 animal units, too. A public hearing for that site is May 12, 2020 at 9:05 a.m. He asked if this is just a rubber stamp, and would like these public hearings to be in person. Supervisor Barnett responded that given the circumstances, telephonic meetings are the best we can do for now. Hoppenworth also asked if the Board would consider a moratorium on hog confinements during COVID-19 and if there was an appeal process if there are legitimate concerns. Specialist Kroeze responded that appeals rarely happen, with little success. The county can submit comments, but that is about all. They hold these public hearings to inform the citizens and give them a chance to comment. Hop-

penworth gave statistics for the number of confinements in Butler County. At the close of the public hearing, it was moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to approve said application for construction. Eddy voted nay. Motion carried.

#### CONSTRUCTION ROAD CLOSURE

WHEREAS, The Butler County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Code of Iowa to close roads or highways under their jurisdiction when necessary for construction, and

WHEREAS, a construction project, RC-C012(112)-9A-12 requires that Butler County Route Union Ave from IA Hwy 3 south one mile to 220<sup>th</sup> Street be closed to thru traffic, and

WHEREAS, local traffic in the vicinity of the construction project will be maintained outside of the construction limits of project RC-C012(112)-9A-12, and

WHEREAS, thru traffic is encouraged to follow alternate route, and
