### MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON MARCH 24, 2020.

With no public access to the courthouse due to COVID-19, this meeting was held telephonically with the public able to participate. This complies with Iowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or impractical".

Meeting called to order telephonically at 9 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with members Greg Barnett and Rusty Eddy present. Also present telephonically were Auditor Lizbeth Williams, Engineer John Riherd, County Attorney Greg Lievens, Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze. First Deputy Auditor Mary Brouwer, HR/Finance Deputy Auditor Mindy Pecha. Recorder Janice Jacobs. Jeff Williams and Rvan Fleshner. Allison, Iowa, Deb Heidenwirth, Greene, Iowa and Bethany Carson Mid-America Publishing.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Time and place for a public hearing on a Construction Permit Application for a new swine facility for Hummel, owner Crayon, LLC. Location of proposed facility is in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 2 Tier 91N Range 17W of Ripley Township. Present telephonically were Auditor Lizbeth Williams. Engineer John Riherd, County Attorney Greg Lievens, Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze. First Deputy Auditor Mary Brouwer, HR/ Finance Deputy Auditor Mindy Pecha, Recorder Janice Jacobs, Jeff Williams and Ryan Fleshner, Allison, Iowa, Deb Heidenwirth, Greene, Iowa and Bethany Carson Mid-America Publishing, Auditor reported one email comment received from Ryan Fleshner, Allison, Iowa, and that Ryan Fleshner was present for comment. Fleshner wanted to confirm the size of the new building and the exact location. Environmental Health Specialist Misty Kroeze responded that is approximately 2,200 feet from his residence to the west, off the road 250 feet on 220th Street. Jeff Williams inquired about the distance from a farmstead that they can spread manure? Misty Kroeze reported 1,250 feet from a farmstead and that it was 1371 from Williams, and across the road. Williams thought the hogs will produce more manure than they can spread on the 80 acre area. Misty Kroeze reported that they will also be spreading west of Allison. Williams thought it would make more sense to be closer to the other land instead of tearing up the roads traveling between the two. Rusty Eddy offered that Iowa Select typically takes measures to reduce the smell such as electronic fences and planting trees. Becky Sexton is a contact for Misty to check if they are taking those measures on this site. Supervisor Eddy asked if construction had started. Misty Kroeze reported that two weeks ago they were waiting for permitting from

the DNR. Because it is under 1,000 animal units no Master Matrix review was needed, and the Board's hands are tied. Ownership of the confinement was questioned, Cravon, LLC is the owner of the facility. Misty Kroeze commented that the ownership is tricky because someone else may own the pigs. Supervisor Eddy suggested that Ryan Fleshner and Jeff Williams contact the owner and ask the same questions of them. Ryan Fleshner wondered about the setback for communication towers. Misty Kroeze offered that the towers go through the Planning and Zoning Commission and the setback is 50 feet from the right of way. Fleshner asked about how close a building could be to a tower. Misty responded it didn't have a setback for an unoccupied residence. At the close of the public hearing, it was moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to approve. All ayes. Motion carried

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Public comment was Janice Jacobs reporting that the Secretary of State's website can provide the concerned citizens the name of the owner of Crayon, LLC.

### CITY OF SHELL ROCK ORDINANCE NO. 373

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHELL ROCK, IOWA, 2013, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAIN-ING TO SEWER SERVICE RATES

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Shell Rock, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 99, Section 99.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Shell Rock, Iowa, 2013, as amended, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

99.03 RATE. Each customer shall pay sewer service charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system in accordance with the following:

1. Residential Property. The charge for each residential property shall be an amount equal to \$5 plus one hundred percent (100%) of the water service charge for the property for the same period; provided, however, in the event the premises is without a water meter, the minimum monthly charge shall be \$16.

2. Heavy Commercial Property. The charge for each heavy commercial property shall be an amount equal to \$5.25 plus one hundred twenty percent (120%) of the water service charge for the property for the same period.

3. School Property. The charge for each school property shall be \$48.40 for each monthly billing period or fraction thereof.

4. County Property. The charge for each County property shall be \$15 for each monthly billing period or fraction thereof.

5. Property Outside of the City. The charge for each property served outside of the corporate limits of the City shall be two hundred percent (200%) of the rate for property within the City limits. The Council may by resolution place other terms and conditions, including connection fees and charges, on service outside the City limits pursuant to Section 95.06. In the event the residential premises is without a City water meter, the minimum monthly charge shall be \$32 (200% of \$16) plus \$5.40 per resident of the premises.

SECTION 2. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

### CITY OF SHELL ROCK ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHELL ROCK, IOWA, 2013, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAIN-ING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Shell Rock, Iowa:

SÉCTION 1. Chapter 106, Section 106.08, subsection 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Shell Rock, Iowa, 2013, as amended, are repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

106.08 COLLECTION FEES. The collection and disposal of solid waste as provided by this chapter are declared to be beneficial to the property served or eligible to be served and there shall be levied and collected fees for the same, in accordance with the following:

(Goreham vs. Des Moines, 1970, 179 NW Second, 449)

1. Rates.

Solid waste shall be stored and collected only in approved containers. The charge for additional approved bags for solid waste collection shall be \$1.75 each. Residential pricing shall include twice monthly curbside recycling collection in approved containers. Lids of all solid waste containers must be completely closed for collection to occur.

B. The monthly charge for a 35-gallon container for a residence meeting the Low Income Elderly Price Guidelines as established by Council resolution shall be \$11.

C. The monthly charge of solid waste collection from a heavy commercial business is \$17.50 per cubic yard dumpster capacity for dumpsters scheduled for one collection per week, and \$35 per cubic yard dumpster capacity for dumpsters scheduled for two collections per week.

D. The monthly charge for solid waste collection from a light commercial business is \$17.50 per cubic yard dumpster capacity for dumpsters scheduled for one collection per week, and \$35 per cubic yard dumpster capacity for dumpsters scheduled for two collections per week; or with a base rate of \$5 and bags; or with an approved container or containers charged as in paragraph A of this subsection for each container, and bags.

E. The monthly charge for a single facility multi-family residential property that is charged as a commercial business (i.e., nursing homes, assisted living facilities, residential facilities) is a base rate of \$5 plus \$1 per cubic yard based on actual usage.

F. Multi-family federally subsidized low rent senior housing and other multi-family residential properties of more than 12 units, including apartments, shall elect as a facility as follows:

(1) If the facility elects to participate in the PAYT plan, then each unit shall use approved containers and participate and be billed according to the PAYT plan above.

(2) If the facility elects not to participate in the PAYT plan, and instead use common refuse containers, then the facility shall be charged \$11 per occupied unit. The cost of the common collection container shall be charged by the collection contractor.

G. Churches and fraternal organization property may elect either: (i) to participate in and be billed as a single residential unit according to the PAYT plan; or (ii) to be charged as a commercial business property described in paragraphs C or D above.

SECTION 2. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
